BVA's Flight for the Fight: Sunday, June 21 at 4pm ET

BVA's Economic Stimulus Package is here: an anonymous member has offered to help our community and a prominent Breast Cancer charity. With the help of BVA's top-notch pilots and controllers, we

can 'stimulate' traffic, funds, and help out a worthwhile cause. On **Sunday, June 21 (from 4-8pm ET)**, six controllers across the Northeast will login at Boston, Albany, and Burlington. Pilots are encouraged to fly with or into the Boston ARTCC, and **for each flight that a pilot completes, \$1 will be donated to "Susan G. Komen for the Cure"**, the global leader of the breast cancer movement. This charity has invested more than \$1 billion since

The "Fight For The Flight" will take place on **Sunday**, **June 21** from 4-8pm ET, and feature six controllers (BOS_Cl, BOS_G, BOS_T, BOS_A, ALB_T, BTV_T, and ZBW_C) across the Boston ARTCC.

its inception in 1982, and works together with breast cancer survivors and activities to save lives, empower people, ensure quality care for all, and energize science to find the cures for breast cancer.

Pilots generate \$1 for each flight. Controllers generate a \$0.10 credit for every pilot they talk to.

We need BVA pilots to come out in full force to raise as much money as we possibly can to support this charity! Fly as many trips as you can with ATC between Boston, Albany, and Burlington, and generate a \$1 credit for each flight. Given a four hour window to fly as many trips as you can between our featured airports in Boston Center, we should be able to raise hundreds of dollars to support breast cancer research! Furthermore, pilots will receive an additional credit for every single Ground, Tower, or Approach controller they talk to during their flight. At the end of the event, the


KBOS, KBTV, and KALB will be staffed for the event. However, pilots are welcome to 'fly in' to ZBW from afar, or depart any other airport covered by Boston Center. More flights means more money for breast cancer, so spread your wings of hope and join us on June 21!

total number of pilot and controller credits will be tallied, and that amount will be donated directly to "Susan G. Komen for the Cure" by a generous BVA member who has decided to remain anonymous. A matching donation will also be made to BVA. While this event costs nothing but time for our members, it offers us the ability to make a meaningful difference in someone's life while doing what we love—flying and controlling at BVA!

Hyper Tension Convention → Thanks to your support during the Hyper Tension Convention, this event is about to become a part of our regular event rotation, and will be held once every quarter (about once every three months). The next "HTC" will be held in New York, and details (as well as the pilot sign-up) are available on the events page. Simply click on the HTC image about halfway down the page to view more information about the event and sign yourself up.

GA Fly-In → Okay, it's not really a new event, but we haven't had one for awhile, so it qualifies.

BVA is bringing back the popular "General Aviation Fly-In" event, which will travel around North

America in search of the most popular general aviation destinations across the United States. Pilots

are requested to fly general aviation aircraft (anything from a Cessna 152 up to a business jet) and

enjoy the beautiful scenery that you can't see from thirty thousand feet. Look for Center or Approach

controllers to overlook the entire event and provide IFR and Flight Following services.

Pack the Pattern → BVA is also proud to re-introduce the "Pack the Pattern" event, designed to replicate the intense traffic surrounding some of the world's busiest airports. Pilots are asked to fly VFR or IFR circuits of Boston, but fly-ins from around the world will also be accepted by Center (try to time your flights to arrive during the busiest portion of the event; be prepared for a long final!). The first event will feature multiple Tower and Approach controllers, as well as Clearance and Ground.

PACK THE PATTERN

Pilots are encouraged to fly into the event or fly IFR or VFR circuits of a busy Class Bravo airport, with full ATC coverage for the entire evening (including Clearance, Ground, multiple Tower and Approach controllers, and maybe even a Center!)




GENERAL AVIATION FLY-IN

Tower (Local) Controllers will feature several small airports designed for General Aviation aircraft. Fly IFR or VFR within controlled airspace; general aviation aircraft (anything from a Cessna to a LearJet) are preferred.

HYPER TENSION CONVENTION

The HTC aims to create the most intense experience for pilots by squeezing eleven controllers into a small airspace, encouraging pilots to sign-up for a departure slot, and keeping blood pressure as high as possible for as long as possible.

FLIGHT FOR THE FIGHT

This special, one-time event asks pilots to come out in full force to stimulate traffic and benefit a good cause. Pilots fly routes around the Northeastern US and receive credit for each flight. The credits are tallied at the end of the event, and one anonymous BVA member donates the money to the Susan G. Komen For the Cure Breast Cancer Society; A matching donation is then made to BVA.
